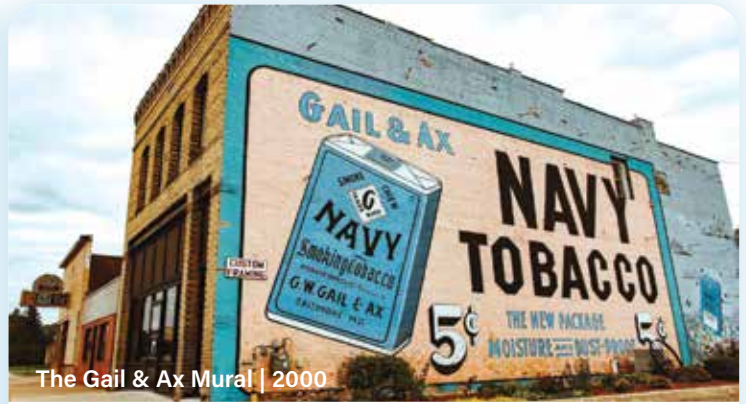

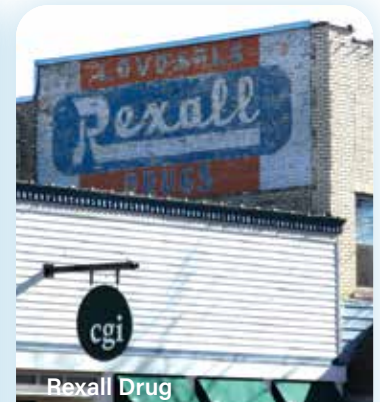

Established in 1992 to protect and restore wetlands and enhance waterfowl and other migratory bird habitat. The Platte River Hiking Trail offers a scenic 3.5-mile hike that leads visitors along the banks of the Platte River to the edge of Rice Lake. The trail consists of 3 loops of varying distances with a one-tenth-mile accessible trail and observation platform near the trailhead. The Platte River Hiking Trail is groomed for cross-country skiing during winter as conditions permit.
