W Broadway on the Mississippi A favorite for residents and visitors alike, this mural depicts the main street of Little Falls in the 1900s.





The trail consists of 3 loops of varying distances with a one-tenth-mile accessible trail and observation platform near the trailhead. The Platte River Hiking Trail is groomed for cross-country skiing during winter as conditions permit.
